SCHOOL OF BUSINESS POLICIES

Minimum Grade

- All School of Business Courses require a minimum grade of C.
- Finance majors are required to earn a B- or higher in FNAN 303

Termination Policy

- Students will not be permitted to make more than three attempts to achieve a C or higher in the following School of Business Core courses:
 - ACCT 303/ACCT 330
 - BULE 303
 - o BUS 303
 - o FNAN 303
 - MGMT 303
 - o MIS 303
 - MKTG 303
 - o OM 303
- Accounting majors will not be permitted to make more than three attempts to achieve a C or higher in Accounting Major courses.
- <u>Once a student has attempted a School of Business Core or Accounting major course</u> twice unsuccessfully, they must meet with an academic advisor in order to receive an override to register for the third attempt. Those who do not successfully complete these core courses within three attempts will be terminated from their major and will not be eligible to receive a degree from the School of Business. Students terminated from the School of Business are prohibited from enrolling in any School of Business course.
