New policy on 12-15 full-time tuition. Emails have been sent. They have deemed financial aid to manage the full, 50%, 33% tuition assistance on this one credit. Need base not on the student it is based on program. Going into effect June 1 and students will get grandfathered in to get priority (does not necessarily mean they will get it).
