This is a typical four year plan for students in the Mathematics BA (Traditional) Program. Your schedule may not look exactly like this. Work with your Mathematics Advisor to design a plan that works best for you!

NOTES: The numbers at the bottom of each column indicate the total credits for that semester and UD indicates the number of those credits that are Upper Division credits (3xx indicates a course 300 or higher). **Cyan** indicates a college requirement (FL.elem I = Foreign Language (elementary level I), FL.int II = Foreign Language (intermediate level II), S.B.S. = Social/Behavioral Science, P.R.S. = Philosophy or Religious Studies, N.W.C. = Non-Western Culture). In this example, it is assumed that the college requirements, excluding the foreign language requirements are courses taken at the upper level. **Red** indicates a course that is only offered at that time of year (e.g. spring or fall). **Green** indicates a general education requirement (W.C. = Western Civ., S.B.S. = Social/Behavioral Science, G.U. = Global Understanding, I.T.eth = Information Technology (ethics component), Synth. = Synthesis). **GMU 3xx** indicates an upper division course which could be an upper division MATH course or an upper division course from another department.
