- Physical Education Courses do not count towards credit hours
- Satisfactory grades are required to receive credit for a course
- Students should select Mason Core courses from the approved Provost's list
- Students should meet with their Academic Advisor at least once a semester to plan their semester schedule

*Students may choose Religious studies related electives from courses in religious studies, anthropology, art history, history, or a scriptural language (Arabic, Biblical Hebrew, Chinese, Classical Greek, Latin, or Sanskrit).

**Students may choose Religious Studies electives at the 300-400 level. They may use up to 6 credits of a scriptural language for this requirement.
